Scene Portrait(Group)

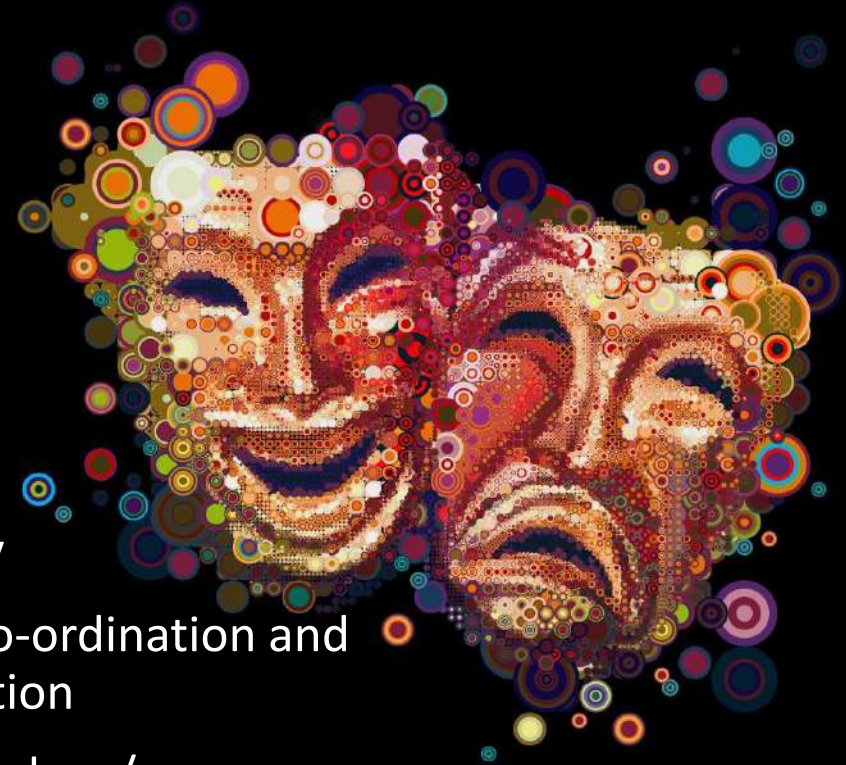
Category II: Class 3&4

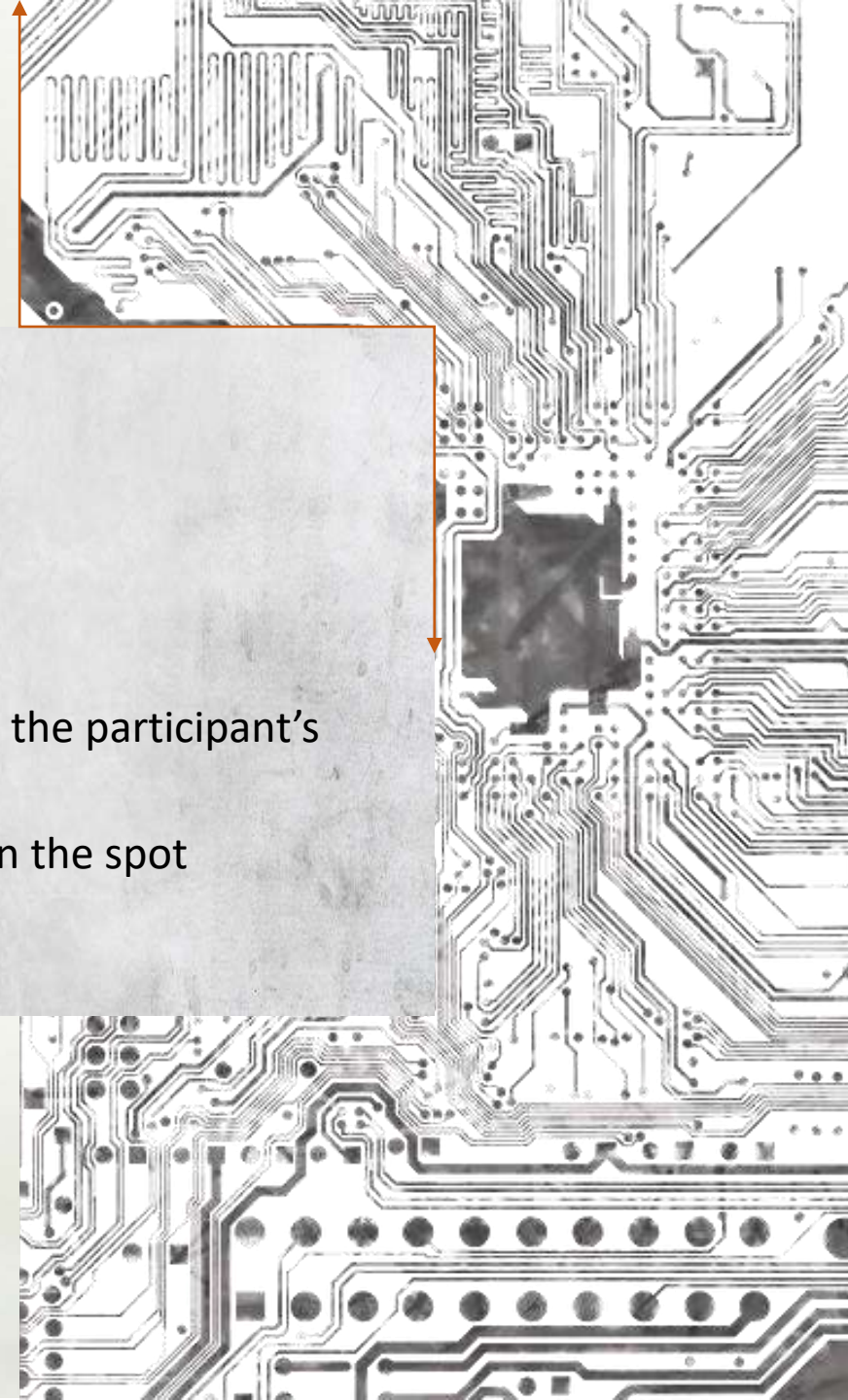

- The material would be rejected if it is not found to be a waste product or second hand item.
- No ready or semi- finished model or matter would be accepted from the participants.
