ANNUAL REPORT OF THE YEAR 2022-23

The school reopened for the academic year 2022-23 on June 1, 2022 with an initiation ceremony. The ceremony was attended by the parents. Before the beginning of the school, formal training for two complete days (8 am to 5 pm) on 11/05/22 and 12/05/22 were given to teachers. The training included methods to be adopted to meet demands of the changing scenario after the Covid pandemic.

To bridge the learning gap of students, bridge course for 15 days was conducted for all classes and all subjects. Environment day was celebrated with lot of fun and interesting programmes like painting competition, quiz, nature hunt etc. Yoga day was celebrated in the school on June 21, 2022. Students of classes 4 and above participated in the programme. Students performed various asanas. Photographs were uploaded in CBSE website. National Reading Day was celebrated in the school with various programmes and participation of number of students. Competitions: Spelling bee, Story Weaving competition etc

Peace student Council Election was conducted on 23/06/22. Head Boy, Head Girl, Cabinet members were selected through secret ballot. International Day against Drug Abuse was organized in the school. An awareness programme was organized by the students.

JULY

Doctors Day was organized in the School on 01/07/23. An awareness talk was conducted by a medical practitioner and she was also honoured. To inculcate values and life skills among students, a charity drive was organized in the school . The amount collected from students was distributed among the needy. The students were divided into groups and taken to various places (old age home, psycho-rehabilitation centres, home for the destitute, cancer patients, shelters) where the money collected was distributed. The students had first-hand knowledge about the activities of such centres. This was done on 05/07/22 and 08/07/22.

Professional training was imparted to teachers for three days from July 14th to 18th. The observation sessions were followed by feedback and criticism. A one-day workshop for kids of grades 1 and 2 were conducted in the school. Kids enjoyed the sessions which were full fun and enjoyment.

Elections for PTA members were conducted on 23/07/22. PTA President and Secretary were selected from the elected members. A webinar in mathematical practices was conducted for class 10 students on 25/07/22. Investiture ceremony was celebrated with pomp and gaiety on 27/07/22. Mr. Vijaya Kumar, a coach and former Navy officer presided over the ceremony. An orientation program for parents on coping skills for students after the pandemic was conducted on 27/07/22. Mr. Jawad, a clinical psychologist led the workshop.

AUGUST

Friendship Day was celebrated in the school. Hiroshima and Nagasaki Remembrance Day was observed on 06/08/22. Students were given awareness about the dangers of war and the need to maintain peace and harmony in the world.

Independence Day was celebrated in the school in a fitting manner. Students and teachers participated in the programmes. On the occasion of 75th year of Independence, flags procured from Kotuvally Panchayat were distributed to students and teachers to be flown in their houses. On 18/08/22 our students participated in the ninth district Junior Throwball Championship held at SNHSS Pullamkulam.

An orientation programme for students of classes 9 and 10 was conducted on 20/08/22. Noted clinical psychologist Mr. Jawad spoke on various issues concerning the adolescents. An orientation programme for teachers was also conducted on the same day. As part of International Senior Citizens Day, our students accompanied by teachers and Principal visited an Old Age Home, Janani Snehalayam at North Paravur. Clothing and other material (new) collected by the students were distributed to the inmates.

Grandparents Day was celebrated on 22/08/22. Various programmes were organized for grandparents. Prizes were distributed to the winners. Students performed various activities in the special assembly conducted in connection with this.

“How to Say No to Drugs”, a special orientation program on drugs and how to say no to drugs was conducted in the school by the Excise Department. The talk was led by Mr. Justin TX, Preventive Officer.

As part of their monthly activity, students of grades Kindergarten and primary classes visited the Fire Station at Mannam, North Paravur. National Sports Day was celebrated in the school on 29/08/22. Students of our school participated in the Freedom Quiz conducted at Al-Ameen School, Edapally. Talent Fiesta, a three-day program showcasing the talents of students, was conducted in the school. The annual fiesta was conducted for three days. Winners were identified in each event.

SEPTEMBER

A one-day training program was organized for teachers. All the teachers attended the program.

OCTOBER

Gandhi Jayanthi was celebrated. Students organized a cleanliness drive in and around the school. Hindi Diwas was also organized on the same day. Mrs. Sumayya, our ward Councillor, inaugurated the cleanliness drive. National Postal Day was celebrated by writing letters to their loved ones and posting them. Students of primary and middle school visited the North Paravur Post Office and learned about the activities there. Students participated in the inter-school competitions held at Al-Ameen Public School on 15/10/22. Our school won the overall 2nd Runners Up Trophy.

in the assembly for eradication of Leprosy. SLC, a festival of literary talents was conducted in the school on 22/10/22. Each student was given a chance to showcase his/her talent and skill.

Students attended the CKS Kalotsav held at Thodupuzha. Many of our students won A grades in addition to B and C grades. 24 students accompanied by teachers participated in the SBOA Tiny Tots Fest held in the school. We won Overall championship. Throw ball team of the school participated in the CKS sports meet at St. Annes School, Koovappady.

NOVEMBER

Keralappiravi was celebrated with variety of programs. An exhibition of traditional food and other items were carried out. On 04/11/22, on the occasion of birth anniversary of Iron Man of India, Sardar Vallabhai Patel, a Unity Run was organized by the school. Students and teachers participated in the run. Photographs were uploaded in the CBSE portal. Children's Day was celebrated with variety of programs. Teachers entertained the students. 32 students attended the CKS Badminton competitions held at St. Mary's Public School, Thuruthipally. Our students also participated in Rugby and Football championships. Maryam Binth Unais of class 8 participated in CBSE state competition and secured A grade. Our school participated in the Noor E-illahi competitions held at Al-Ameen Public School, Edapally. 32 students of our school participated in the CKS Sports Meet held at CMI Public School, Chalakkudy. Many students won laurels in the event. Kanz Rahman of our school was selected for the CBSE National Sports Meet held at Varanasi.

DECEMBER

World Arabic Day was observed in the school. Various programs and an exhibition was organized in this connection. Students of all classes went for one-day picnic to various locations accompanied by teachers. A farewell party was organized for outgoing students of our school on 05/12/22.

JANUARY

An orientation and motivation program was organized for students of 8, 9 and 10. The event was led by soft-skill trainer Mr. Jason Arakkal. Sports Day was conducted on 11/01/23 for the school at Maharajas College Grounds, on a synthetic track. Mr. Robin Menon, SAI instructor and former coach of cricketer, Mr. Sreesanth, was the chief guest. An observation and training program for teachers was conducted on 13/01/23. In addition to this, a one-day workshop on effective teaching methods was conducted in the school on 14/01/23 from 8 am to 5 pm. Principal and HM attended observation duties at KV Port Trust. Republic Day was celebrated. Students and teachers attended the well-organized program.

FEBRUARY.

The school follows regular reviews of the academic matters. We have HODs for each subject and regular, weekly meetings are organized and minutes are maintained. Staff meetings are conducted every Thursday. Important events are discussed. Minutes are maintained.

Continuous and comprehensive evaluation of the students is done and records are maintained. Open house is conducted after periodic assessments and term evaluations. Parents get ample chance to meet and discuss about the academic and co-scholastic progress of their wards. Equal importance is given to physical, emotional and social wellbeing of the students and teachers.

In addition to the in-house trainings given to teachers, teachers also attend trainings offered by CBSE in both online and offline mode. Records of all these are maintained.
