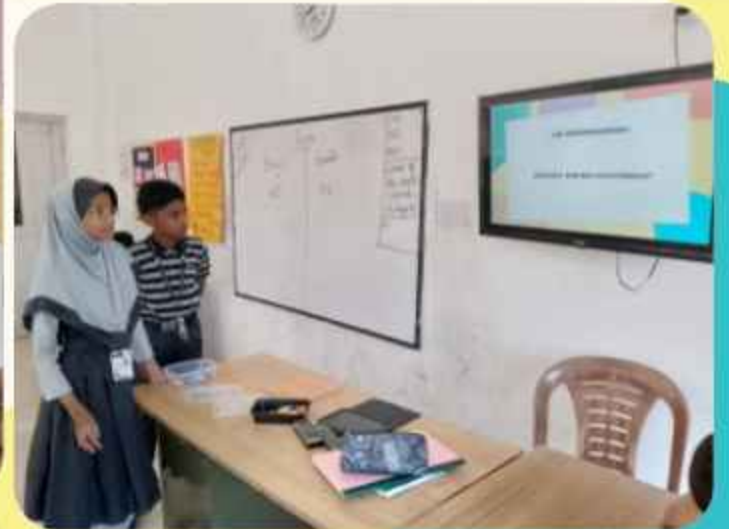
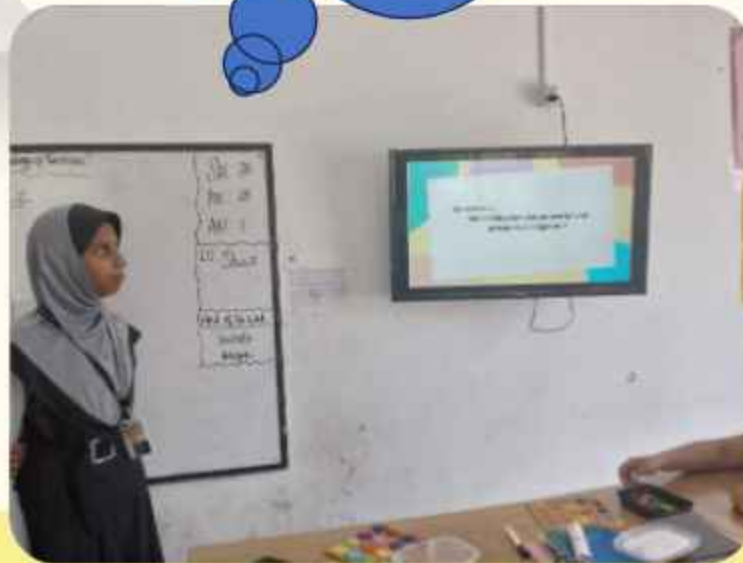

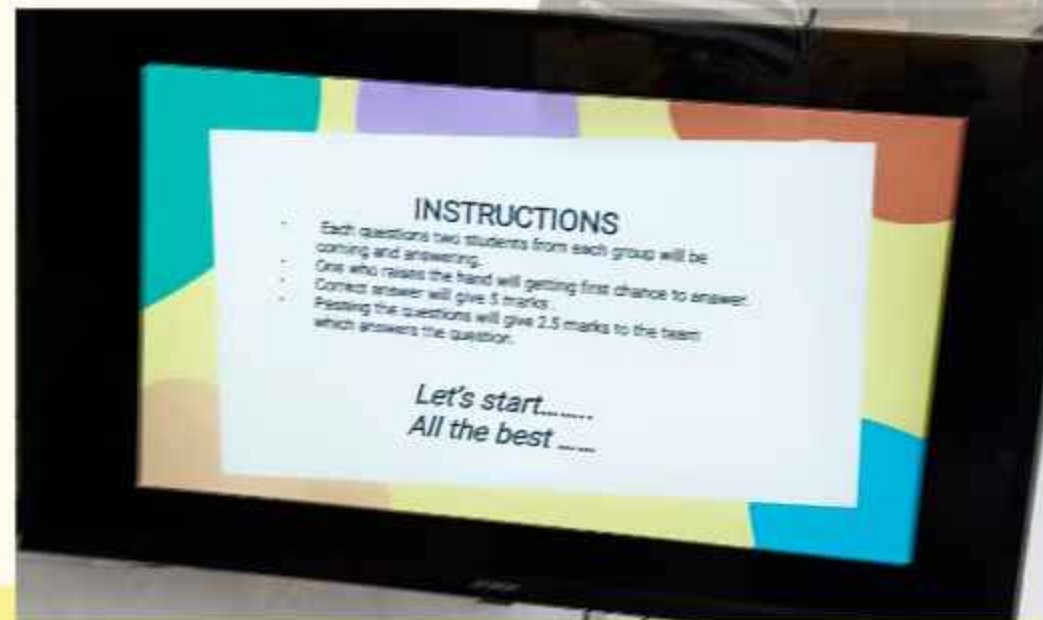

Jute

- Jute is known as the golden fiber.
- It requires a hot and wet climate with high temperature (25-30°C).
- It requires high rainfall (100-200 cm).
- The stem and leaf blades are used.
- Part of the world's jute comes from India and Bangladesh.
