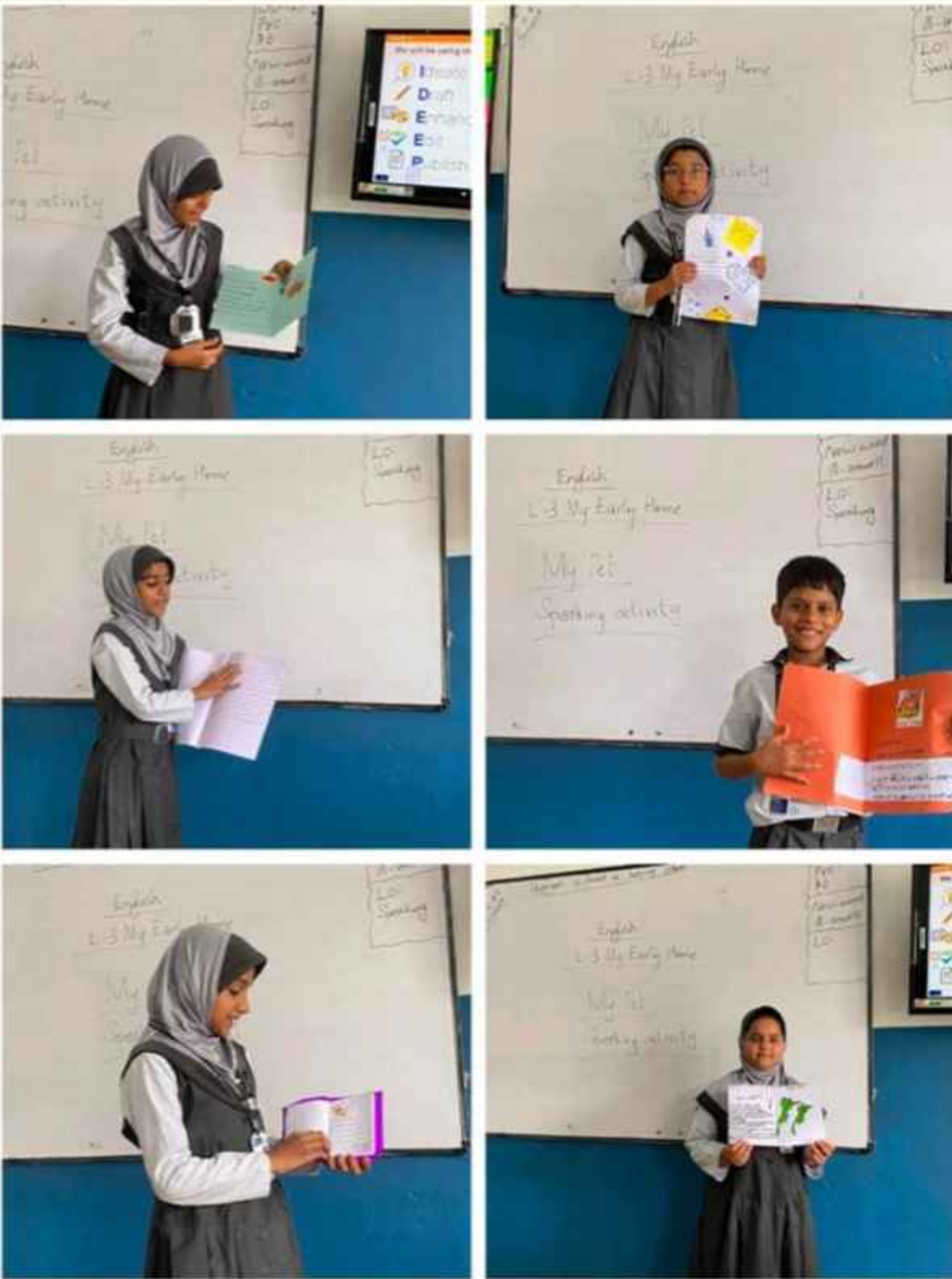
# Grade 4 A

## *Making a scrap book about John Cadbury*



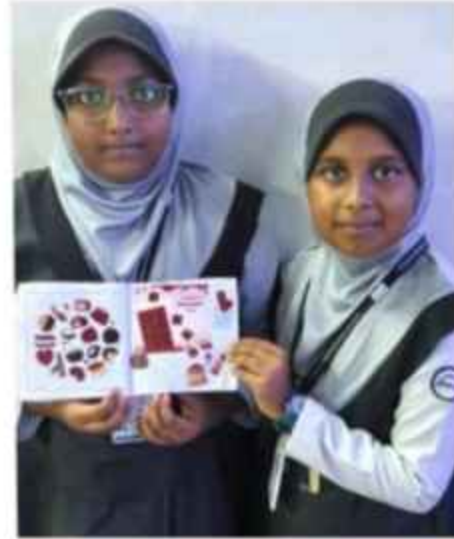
- To encourage research skills by learning about John Cadbury and the history of chocolates.

# Grade 6 B

- To develop writing skills by including a simple chocolate recipe.
- To stimulate curiosity and creativity by collecting and presenting interesting facts about chocolates.





# Grade 7 A

## Word Association Game

- It's a simple game that encourages quick thinking and vocabulary expansion. Students had to make connections based on various relationships like categories, synonyms, antonyms, or things that are commonly found together..





# Grade 7 B

## Word Association Game

- Word Association is a common word game involving an exchange of words that are associated together. The game is based on the noun phrase word association, meaning "stimulation of an associative pattern by a word".
