- ❖ To develop hand - eye coordination.



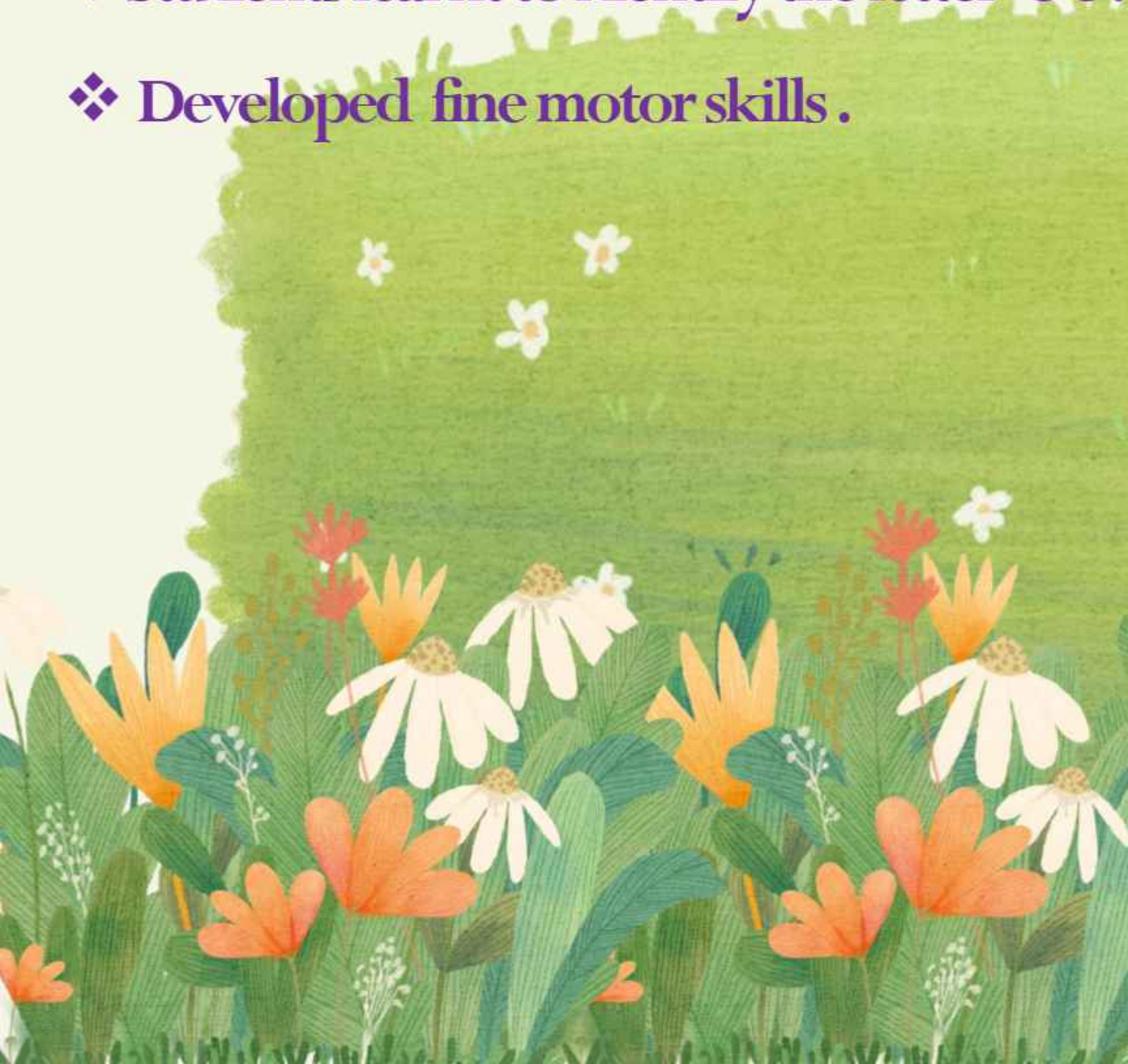


LETTER 'C' CRAFT

STRAW PRINTING

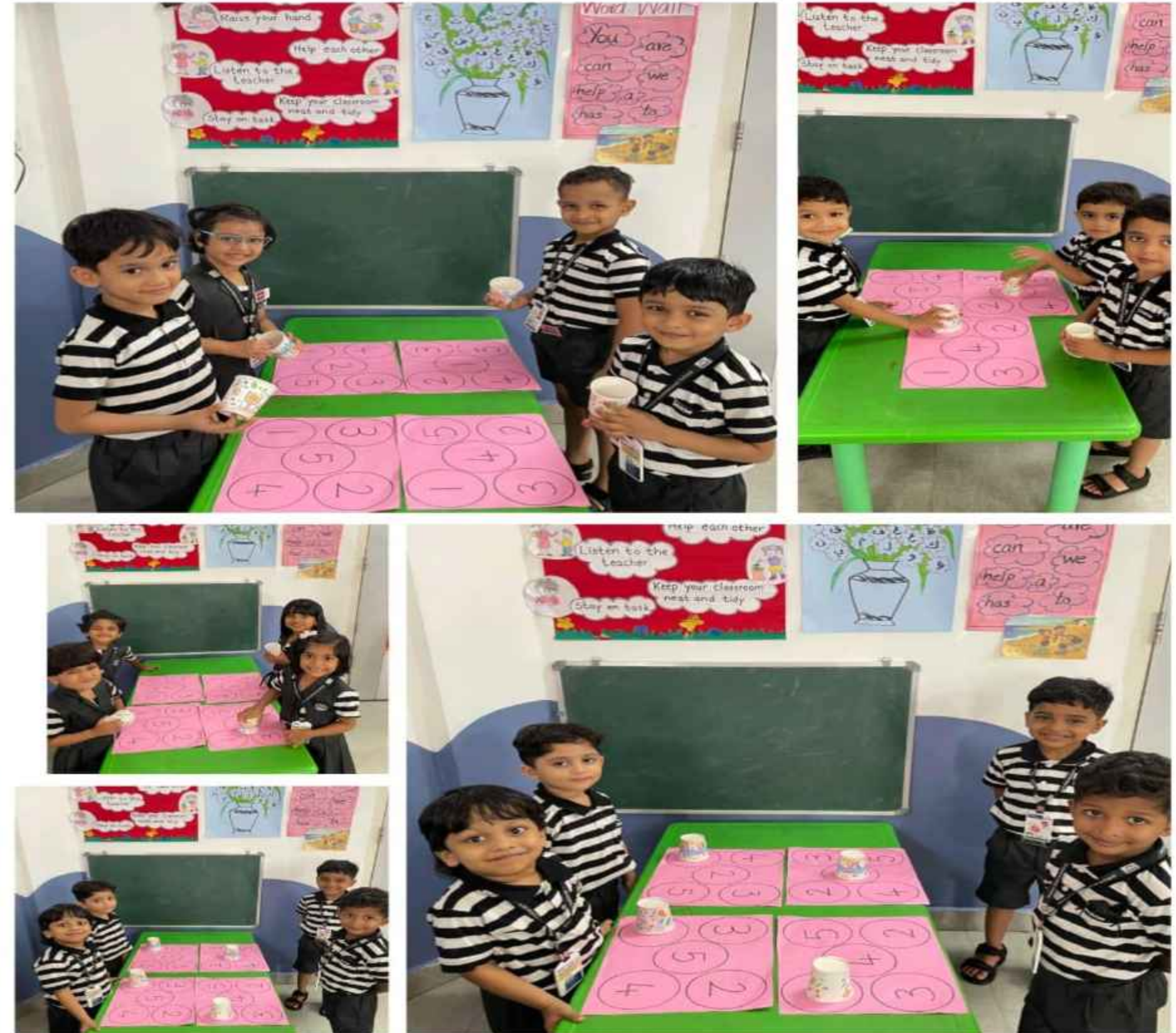


Through this activity students enhanced their hand and eye coordination. The activity helped build a stronger foundation of learning the letter 'F' with the phonic sound.
